



Logan Preemie Hat

Crochet pattern design by Debbie Field

Protect that precious little head with a simple, quick preemie hat. The Logan Preemie Hat starts with double crochets and ends with a sweet border of granny stitches. It provides the warmth a preemie needs.

What could be sweeter than a crochet preemie hat? This little hat is perfect for gifting to someone special or donating to your local NICU.

Yarn

Premier Yarns “Cotton Sprout” 100% cotton
DK weight (230yds/3.5oz; 210m/100g)
Approx. 40 yds of Teal

Hook

US size G-7 (4.5mm)

Finished Size

Approx. 5" across x 4.5" high to fit 10.5"
head circumference

- The hat is laid flat and measured from crown to bottom edge for the height and across the GS border for the width

Gauge

14-15 dc x 8 rnds = Approx. 4"

Skill Level: Advanced Beginner

**Abbreviations – US crochet terminology**

beg – beginning

ch – chain

dc – double crochet

MR – magic ring

rep – repeat

rnd(s) – round(s)

sc – single crochet

sk – skip

sp – space

st(s) – stitch(es)

RS – right side

YO – yarn over

Repeats

(...) – Work everything within the parentheses in the same st or sp.

[...] – Repeat everything within the brackets the indicated number of times.

Special Stitches

Granny stitch (GS) - 3 dc in the same st or sp

Increase (inc) - work 2 dc in the same st

Stacked single crochet (STsc) – (This stitch is used at the beginning of a round to replace the traditional turning ch-3. It has the appearance of a dc.) – Insert hook in the same st as the loop, YO, pull up a loop, YO, pull through 2 loops (bottom sc made), insert hook through the left vertical bar of the bottom sc, YO, pull up a loop, YO, pull through 2 loops (top sc made).

Pattern Notes

1. Do not turn after any rnd.
2. A ch-2 or ch-3 may be substituted for the STsc at any time without affecting the construction.
3. The STsc is worked in the next st instead of the st with the join to hide the seam. Be sure to work the last st into the st with the join.
4. The GS in the final rnd are worked in the space between GS from the rnd before where a ch-1 space normally would be.
5. Count often.

Pattern Instructions

Rnd 1 (RS): (STsc, 11 dc) in a MR, tighten the ring at the end of the rnd, OR ch 3, join with slip st to form a ring, (STsc, 11 dc) in the ring, join with slip st to beg st. < 12 dc >

Rnd 2 (RS): (STsc, dc) in the 1st st, inc in each st around, join with slip st to beg st. < 24 dc >

Rnd 3: STsc, inc in the next st, [dc in the next st, inc in the next st] around, join with slip st to beg st. < 36 dc >

Rnd 4: STsc in the next st, dc in the next st and in each st around, join with slip st to beg st.

Rnds 5-8: Rep Rnd 4.

Rnd 9: Slip st in the next st, (STsc, 2 dc) in the same st (counts as the 1st GS), sk 2 sts, [GS in the next st, sk 2 sts] around, join with slip st to beg st. < 12 GS >

Rnd 10: STsc in the sp to the right of the hook, GS in the next sp and in each sp around, 2 dc in the same sp as the beg STsc to complete the 1st GS, join with slip st to beg st.

Fasten off and weave in ends.
